

PUBLIC NOTICE

Local Government Act 2009

- McKinlay Shire Council (the "Council") has proposed to make -
 - Model Local Law No. 1 (Administration) 2018;
 - Model Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2018;
 - Model Local Law No. 3 (Community and Environmental Management) 2018;
 - Model Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2018;
 - Subordinate Local Law No. 1 (Administration) 2018;
 - Subordinate Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2018;
 - Subordinate Local Law No. 3 (Community and Environment Management) 2018;
 - Subordinate Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2018.
- Possible anti-competitive provisions have been identified in the proposed local laws and subordinate local laws. Council has proposed to conduct a public interest test in relation to possible anti-competitive provisions identified in each proposed local law and subordinate local law in respect of which possible anti-competitive provisions have been identified.
- The local law which authorises the making of each proposed subordinate local law is identified in schedule 1, column 3.
- The purpose and general effect of each proposed local law and subordinate local law is identified in schedule 1, column 4.
- Written submissions by any person in support of, or objecting to, a proposed local law and/or a proposed subordinate local law are invited for a 21 day period commencing on **15th December 2018** and ending on **18th January 2019** (the "consultation period").
- During the consultation period Council will make available for inspection and purchase at Council's public office at **29 Burke Street, Julia Creek QLD 4823 copies of-**
 - (a) each proposed local law; and
 - (b) each proposed subordinate local law; and
 - (c) if a proposed local law or subordinate local law contains a possible anti-competitive provision—a public interest test plan for the proposed local law or subordinate local law.
- Submissions must be received on or before **Friday 18th January 2019 stating-**
 - (a) the grounds of the submission; and
 - (b) the facts and circumstances relied on in support of the grounds.
