Results of the Bush Dinner Meeting held 18 May 2021

We are really pleased that there is interest in the community to keep this initiative going as we know it delivers very positive social and economic impact to our community.

Key Points:

- 1. The Queensland Government's recent announcements state that outdoor events with no dancing are permitted to operate *without* a COVID Safe Event Checklist or a COVID Safe Event Plan.
- 2. The consensus from the meeting is that the price should rise to \$20 per person
- 3. Council will establish an online ticketing platform through Eventbrite for the bush dinner season so that travellers will be able to purchase their tickets weeks in advance.
- 4. Online ticketing numbers will be capped at 100.
- 5. Council staff will continue to assist with these events however we are not currently able to operate the bus.

To cover the peak season, we need to cater for 13 nights which hinges on the number of groups that wish to host/cater.
