Eligibility for the Pfizer COVID-19 Vaccine varies by location as outlined below:

Persons, regardless of age, will be eligible for vaccination by the visiting Mobile COVID-19 (Pfizer) Vaccination Clinics if they are a North West resident of the following communities (proof of residential address may be requested by clinic staff):

- Doomadgee
- Mornington Island
- Burketown
- Dajarra
- Camooweal
- Urandangi
- Gregory Downs

In other areas where there is a plan for local access to the AstraZeneca COVID-19 Vaccine, North West residents within the following groups are eligible for vaccination with the Pfizer COVID-19 Vaccine:

- Persons between 16 and 49 years of age
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people of any age
- This includes the following communities:
 - Normanton
 - Karumba
 - Cloncurry
 - Julia Creek
 - McKinlay
 - Mount Isa – Eligibly for vaccination in the Mount Isa Clinics will be determined as per the current ATAGI Priority Groups (outlined above)
