

#### NORTH QUEENSLAND LIVESTOCK INDUSTRY RECOVERY AGENCY

**INFORMATION FOR INDIVIDUALS, FARMS AND COMMUNITIES** 

### IMMEDIATE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

You may be eligible for a range of one-off payments and grants to assist with immediate recovery efforts. All claims will be assessed on an individual basis and are not dependent on the circumstances of others – they are designed to support everyone to get back on their feet.

**Restocking and Replanting Grant and On-Farm Infrastructure Grant:** Eligible Primary Producers can apply for up to \$400,000 seed funding to assist with restocking, replanting and replacement of on-farm infrastructure damaged by flooding. The grant will need to be matched by a 50 per cent co-contribution. The Australian Government is working with the Queensland Government on delivering the grants to primary producers. Further information on how to apply will be available soon.

<u>Special Disaster Recovery Grants (Primary Producers)</u>: Up to \$75,000 to assist Category C and D primary producers with a range of clean-up and reinstatement activities. **Apply by 11 August.**

<u>Special Disaster Recovery Grants (Small Businesses and Not-For-Profits)</u>: Up to \$50,000 to assist small businesses and not-for-profit organisations with a range of clean-up and reinstatement activities.

Disaster Recovery Payment: One-off payment of \$1000 per adult and \$400 per child. Apply by 30 August.
