I have received a copy of the guidelines "Transportation of Fodder Associated with a Natural Disaster Event", (available on the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry website) and this application complies with the conditions and requirements detailed in the fodder guidelines which applied at the date/s of consignment; and
- 7. the costs of the fodder described in the claim (on page 3) and the cost of freight for transport of the fodder have been paid in their entirety and the necessary **original** tax invoices are attached, and
- **8.** the distance claimed for the movements was the shortest practicable route; and
