

PUBLIC NOTICE

ROADWORKS IN JULIA CREEK TOWNSHIP

Julia Creek residents, business owners and road users are advised that civil construction works will commence from the week starting **Monday 4 May 2026** at several locations within the township.

These works are being delivered to improve road safety, traffic flow and heavy vehicle access within key areas of town.

Work Locations (plans below)

- Burke Street – adjacent to the school
- Burke Street – west of the Fire Station
- Laneway entrance off Mathews Street – beside the RSL

The project will include:

- Construction of a raised concrete pedestrian crossing near the school to improve pedestrian safety and help reduce vehicle speeds.
- Intersection upgrades at the laneway and Mathews Street to improve turning movements for heavy vehicles.
- Associated repairs to the adjoining RSL fence and surrounding infrastructure.

Traffic Management

Works will be undertaken in stages to minimise disruption to residents, businesses and motorists.

During construction there will be:

- Traffic control personnel onsite
- Temporary lane closures
- Signed detours where required
- Reduced speed limits through work zones

Motorists are asked to follow all signage and directions from traffic controllers for the safety of workers and the community.

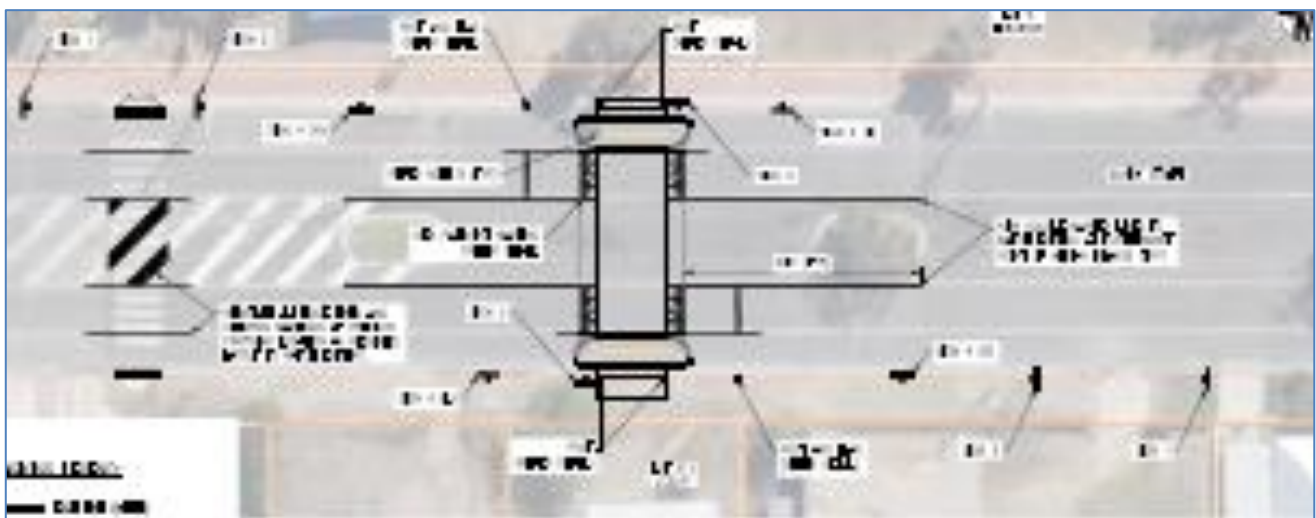

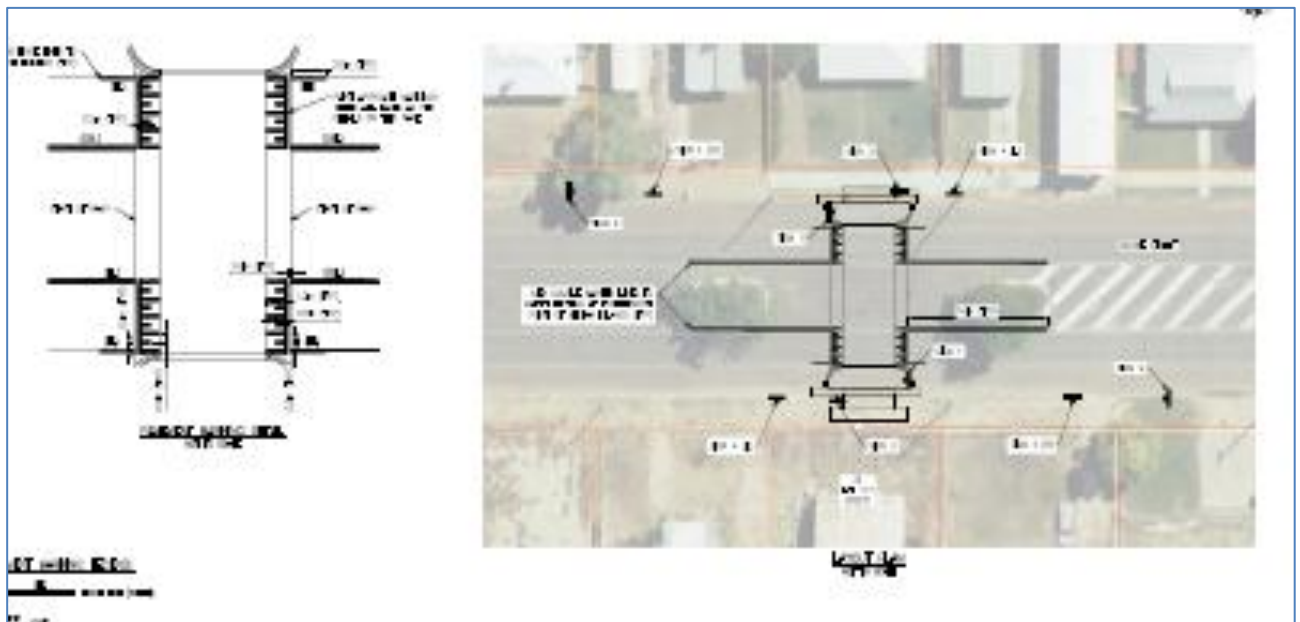

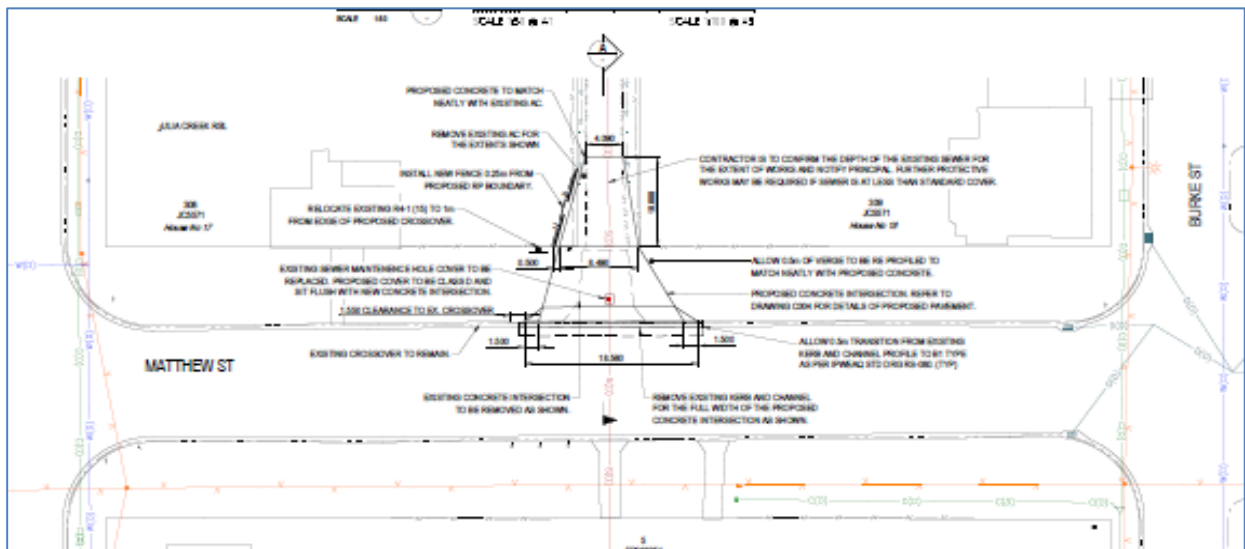
